

Nomenclature changes in Afrotropical Pterophoridae (Lepidoptera)

Early 2008 (Gielis, 2008) I have described some new species of Pterophoridae from the African continent. Recently I have visited the Transvaal Museum in Pretoria, Republic of South Africa. This collection holds a great number of specimens from the southern half of Africa. It was here I discovered that I had created two synonyms. Also the generic position of the valid species needed to be changed. The results are tabulated as:

Pselnophorus jaechi (Arenberger, 1993) (*Pterophorus*), **Comb. n.**

Type locality: Kenya.

Pselnophorus meruensis Gielis, 2008, **Syn. n.**

Type locality: Tanzania.

and

Eucapperia bullifera (Meyrick, 1918) (*Platyptilia*), **Comb. n.**

Type locality: Republic of South Africa.

Eucapperia continentalis Gielis, 2008, **Syn. n.**
